

Gobabeb MSc Student Associate, Silke Rügheimer, is characterising the endemic plant, !nara (Acanthosicyos horridus). One specific objective of her research is to determine the periods of flowering and fruiting across its distribution range in Namibia. To enrich her own dataset, she is sourcing as many documented observations as possible, and is calling on the assistance of Namibian naturalists and visitors to the Namib.
